

LEGO® Bingo - LOLUG will operate BINGO with a LEGO® twist. LEGO® prizes include sets, polybags, posters and more!

LEGO® Mosaic Activity - LOLUG will be hosting a new activity in which our guests can build a LEGO® mosaic on a 16x16 baseplate which will be hung for all to see throughout the day. LEGO® prizes will be awarded to the best mosaic twice a day! The vote will be conducted by members of LOLUG.

LEGO® Graffiti Wall - Another new activity in which our guests are encouraged to build something on our wall - either a message, a design, or wherever your creativity takes you.


LEGO® Play Brick - Our large tables filled with LEGO® to let your hearts run wild! Build something amazing!
